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69 **STATISTICS REPORT ON NCEES EXAMS, FLORIDA JURISDICTIONAL EXAMINATION,**
70 **AND LICENSED BUSINESSES**

72 Mr. Green reported the following results for NCEES Fundamentals of Surveying and Principles
73 and Practices of Surveying Examinations as of May 1, 2025, to July 25, 2025:

75 ☐ NCEES Fundamentals of Surveying Exam – 14 passed and 13 failed for a total of
27 exams.

78 ☐ NCEES Principles and Practices of Surveying Exam - 10 passed, 8 failed, and 3 results
79 not available, for a total of 21 exams.

81 Ms. Lee reported the following results for the Florida Jurisdictional Examination and newly
82 created Florida Surveying and Mapping businesses from May 1, 2025, to July 29, 2025:

84 ☐ Florida Jurisdictional Examination – 26 were licensed, 3 need to take other
85 examinations to become licensed, and 1 failed, for a total of 30 exams.

87 ☐ 19 new Florida surveying and mapping businesses were licensed.

89 **OLD BUSINESS**

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91 Mr. Cross stated that the Exam rules revisions will be discussed during the Rules Committee.

93 **NEW BUSINESS**

95 Mr. Cross stated that there is a proposed change to remove the Public Land Surveying Systems (PLSS) exam questions from the NCEES Principles and Practices exam and create a separate PLSS exam. He stated that these changes are scheduled for June 2027. He stated that it would require an additional examination to be given to Florida surveying candidates, which would require statute and rule changes. Mr. Zoltek stated that the state of Florida is not required to use the additional exam unless the Board chooses to do so. Ms. Hall stated that since the PLSS exam questions are being removed, she suggests that we adopt the NCEES PLSS examination. Mr. Cross concurred. Mr. Green said if the Board decides to go this route, that the rule language needs to be worked as soon as possible to submit and go through the processes to have the rule adopted by June 2027.
