

How To: Find a Certified Shellfish Processing Facility

1.1 Title

How To: Find a Certified Shellfish Processing Facility. This video will show you how to find certified shellfish processing facilities on the Florida Aquaculture Interactive Atlas. On another device scan the QR code or use another browser tab to visit the website www.FDACS.gov/Agriculture-Industry/Aquaculture/Shellfish-Harvesting-Area-and-Aquaculture-Lease-Map to follow along. It is recommended to access the Florida Aquaculture Interactive Atlas on a desktop or laptop for optimal functionality. The Florida Aquaculture Interactive Atlas has limited capability on a mobile device.

1.2 Select

We will begin by selecting the “Layers” option from the menu at the top left of the map screen. It looks like a stack of papers.

1.3 Select

Ensure that the layer “Certified Shellfish Processing Facilities” is viewable on the map, this is shown by an open eye icon on the right side of the layer. If this layer is hidden the eye will be closed. Select the icon to enable visibility of the layer.

1.4 Select

Select the second option from this menu titled “Legend”. We can see that certified shellfish processing facilities are shown on the map with an orange dot.

1.5 Select

Select the “X” to close the “Layers” menu.

1.6 Select

You can search for a specific certified shellfish processing facility using two methods. Begin by selecting the “Search” option from the menu at the top left of the map screen. The icon is a magnifying glass.

1.7 Select

Here you can type in the physical address of a certified shellfish processing facility to search for it on the Atlas.

1.8 Select

The map will automatically zoom into the location entered in the search bar. Select the certified shellfish processing facility to view more information. For this example, we will be using Oyster Boss Oyster Co., LLC.

1.9 Banner

An informational banner about the selected certified shellfish processing facility will open. Scroll or use the arrows to view more information.

1.10 Select

You can also choose to use your location to search for certified shellfish processing facilities around your current location. To do this select the option for “Use Current Location”.

1.11 Allow Location Services

If you choose to use the “Use current location” feature, ensure that location services are enabled on your device. Select an option that allows the Atlas to access your location to enable location services.

1.12 Select

The map will automatically zoom in to your location. You may select a certified shellfish processing facility of your choice to view more information.

1.13 Scroll

An informational banner about the selected certified shellfish processing facility will open. Scroll or use the arrows to view more information.

1.14 Access the Florida Aquaculture Interactive Atlas

You can now use the Atlas to view certified shellfish processing facilities in Florida.
