88 it was decided by the Board that the meeting would be held in the Tampa/St.
89 Petersburg/Clearwater area and the new meeting date would be April 29, 30,
90 and May 1, 2026.

92 Mr. Green mentioned that for the Board to participate in the Florida Surveying
93 and Mapping Society's conference, the dates for the July meeting would need
94 to be on July 27-29, 2026, in Aventura, Florida. The Board agreed with these
95 dates.

96 Mr. Green said that there was also an issue with the October PSAM meeting
97 dates because some of the Board members are attending the Florida
98 Surveying and Mapping Society's cruise and it would cause a conflict. After
99 discussion, the Board agreed to revise the dates for the Fall Board meeting to
100 September 28-30, 2026, in St. Augustine, Florida.
