Course Details

The Florida Forest Service and UF/IFAS Extension Clay County will be conducting a Certified Pile Burners Course in two 4-hour virtual sessions to be held on May 19th and 20th from 8am – 12noon each day. This course will show you how to burn piles legally, safely, and efficiently. If you burn piles regularly, do not delay registering for this training. When the weather is dry, certified pile burners receive priority for authorization to burn. Certified pile burners may also burn up to two hours longer per day and receive multi-day authorizations. This training will be held via Zoom. After registration and payment, the Zoom link and printed course materials will be mailed to you.
