TARGET	APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS
Housing	2 fl. oz. (60 ml) Elector PSP in 10 gallons of water will treat 5,000 - 10,000 ft ² . Use enough water in a directed spray to contact flies and their resting surfaces. Spray thoroughly, but do not allow run-off to occur. Do not contaminate feedstuffs, water or watering and feeding equipment with premise treatment. Re-application may occur every 7 to 10 days as needed, or when fly populations reach nuisance levels.
