

Subject: FDACS Examination Update - September 2025

Dear Valued Industry Professionals,

We're sharing an important update regarding pesticide license testing in Florida. The final transition from the University of Florida's IFAS Extension (UF/IFAS) to Everblue will take effect on **October 1, 2025**.

Key Changes & Dates

- **September 30, 2025:** Last day UF/IFAS will administer exams at extension offices.
- **October 1, 2025:** All exams—remote and in-person—will be managed by Everblue.

Testing Options

- **Remote Exams** Already available and scheduled directly through Everblue.

 Cost: \$32

 Flexible testing from any location.

- **In-Person Exams** Available at Everblue test centers across Florida.

 Cost: \$59

How to Register for Everblue Exams

To schedule either exam type:

1. Apply to FDACS for an exam voucher at <<https://aeslicensing.fdacs.gov>>
2. If approved, you'll receive an email with instructions on how to pay for and schedule your exam(s) through Everblue.

In addition to Everblue-proctored exams, FDACS will host two sessions with **waived proctoring fees** (application fees still apply). Advance sign-up will be required. Details regarding availability and sign up will be shared soon.
