

Important Update: Sulfuryl Fluoride Product Labeling Requirements

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The Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Agricultural Environmental Services would like to make you aware of an important regulatory update that will impact your operations. All sulfuryl fluoride products distributed after July 11, 2025, must carry updated labeling that includes the new interim mitigation measures.

Please note: where the revised labels contain language that is more restrictive than what is currently outlined in Chapter 482, Florida Statutes, or Chapter 5E-14, Florida Administrative Code, the Department will enforce the stricter label requirements.

To support consistency with this change, the Department is actively drafting updates and will soon enter the formal rulemaking process to revise Chapter 5E-14, F.A.C. to align with the new labels.

We appreciate your attention to this matter and recommend reviewing the updated product labels to ensure full compliance ahead of use.

For your review are documents from registrants Douglas Products (Vikane) and Ensystem (Zythor) summarizing the changes on each products label. These documents are summaries only and is not a substitute for review of the full label/labeling directions.
