

BASIC FIRE MANAGEMENT

Overview: This 40 hour training includes portions of I-100, Introduction to ICS and L-180, Human Factors in the Wildland Fire Service along with the S-190, Introduction to Wildland Fire Behavior and S-130, Firefighter Training. These are the entry level courses for new firefighters and fire managers. Course will include live fire field exercises.

Objectives:

- Overview & introduction to the Incident Command System
- Fire Behavior factors
- Fire Weather elements
- Firefighting resources & equipment & communications
- Firefighter safety, urban interface & hazardous materials
- Firefighting tactics, patrolling & mop-up

Prerequisites: Physically fit to participate in live-fire field exercises. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) may be available for loan (Please contact course coordinator before course). Full PPE will be required – 8” lace-up, leather Boots, Eye and Hearing protection, Nomex/Fire Resistant pants and long sleeve shirt, Gloves, Helmet.
