

S-359 MEDICAL UNIT LEADER

Overview: This 21 hour course is designed to provide the skills and knowledge needed to perform in the role of medical unit leader (MEDL). Topics include gathering information, organizing the medical unit, supervising the unit, evaluation, documentation, and demobilization. Various incidents and related response will be reviewed (e.g. Dutch Creek Protocols).

Objectives:

- Plan, staff, and manage the medical unit.
- Coordinate with other incident entities as necessary.
- Respond to medical emergencies and transport patients.
- Describe how to provide high quality patient care.

Prerequisites: Current certification as Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) or equivalent.
