

S-203, INTRODUCTION TO INCIDENT INFORMATION

Description: The purpose of this 30 hour (3 hours pre-course work) course is to provide students with the skills and knowledge needed to serve as Public Information Officers ([PIOF](#)). The course covers establishing and maintaining an incident information operation, communicating with internal and external audiences, working with the news media, handling special situations, and long-term planning and strategy.

Objective: Students will demonstrate the skills and knowledge of a Public Information Officer ([PIOF](#)) by successfully participating in a simulation and passing a written exam.

Target Group: Personnel desiring to be qualified as Public Information Officer ([PIOF](#)).

Prerequisites: Satisfactory completion of pre-course work.
