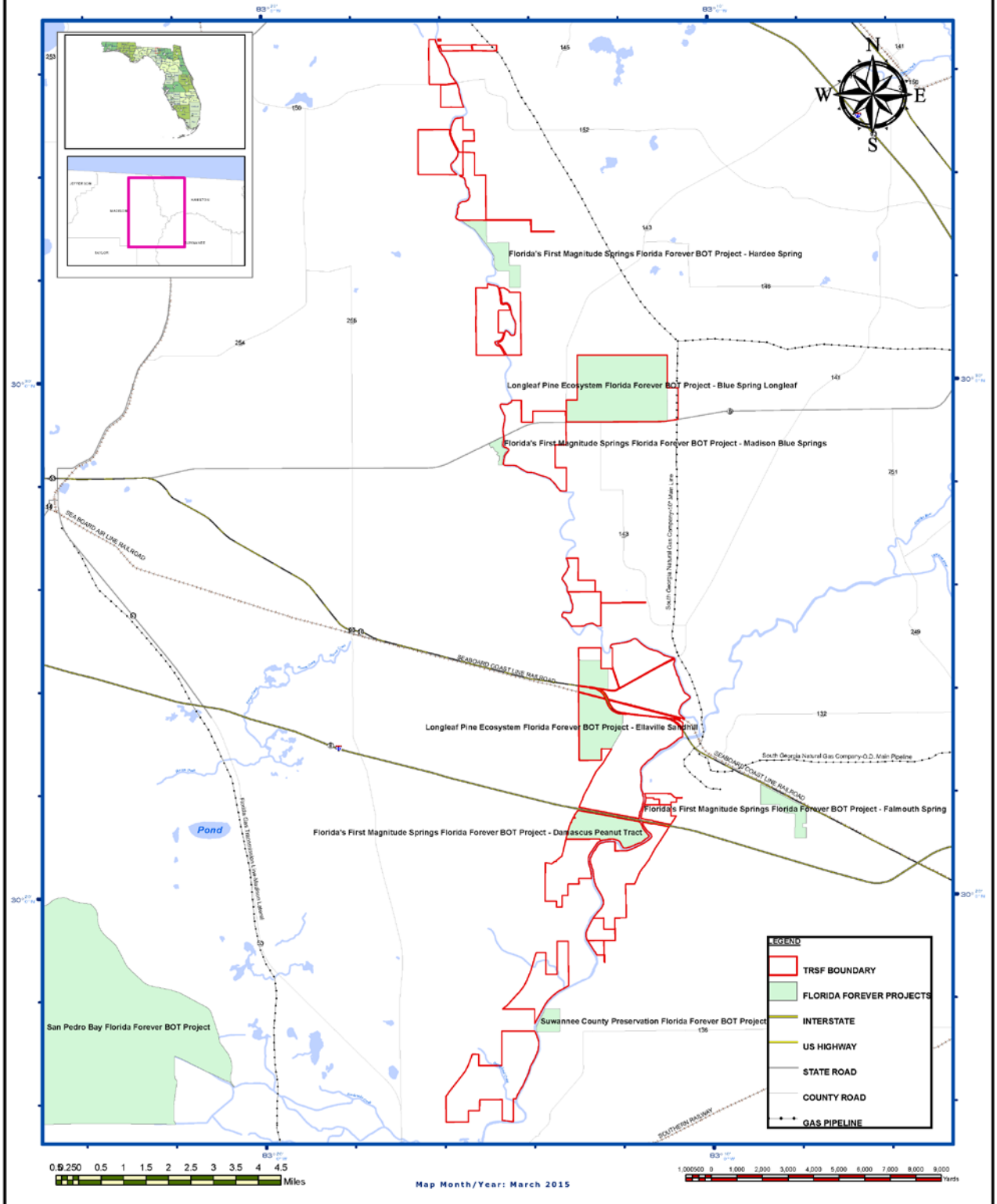
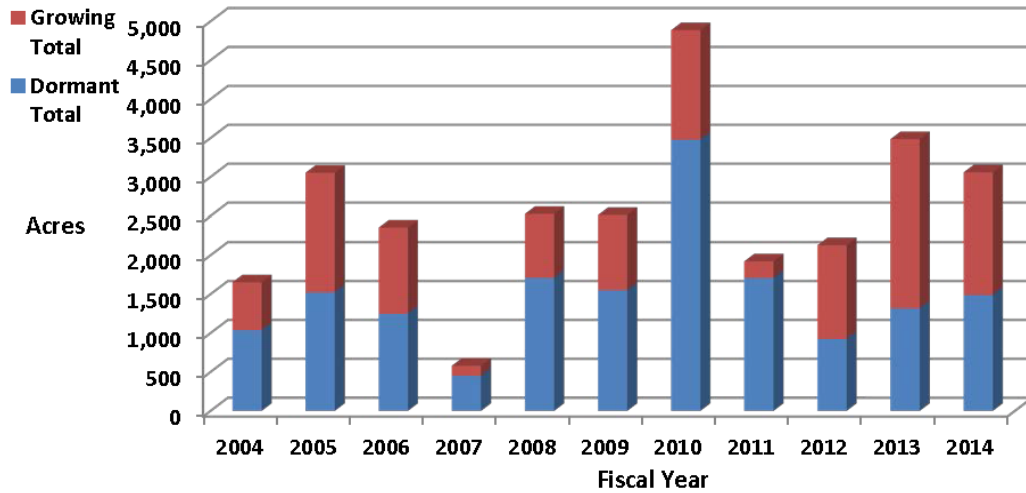

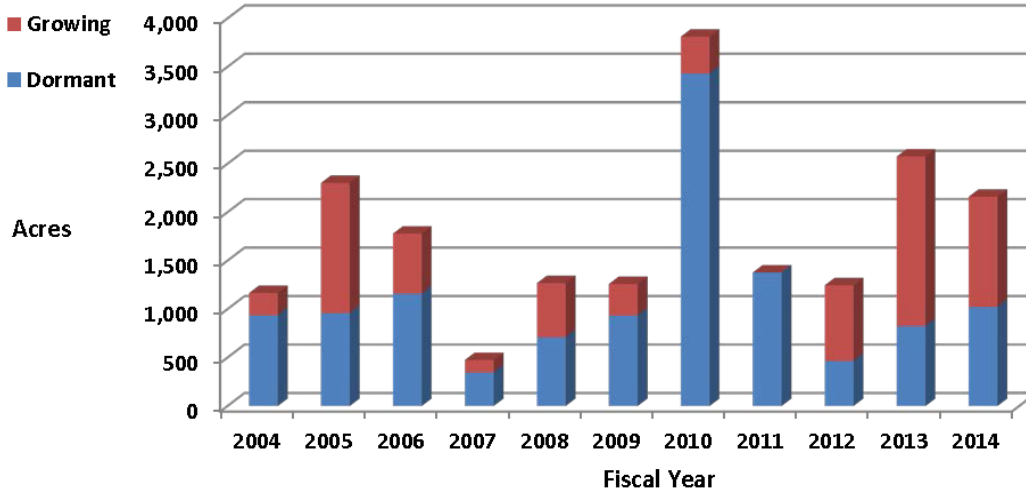
Fire History & Burnable Acres

10-Year Prescribed Burning Summary

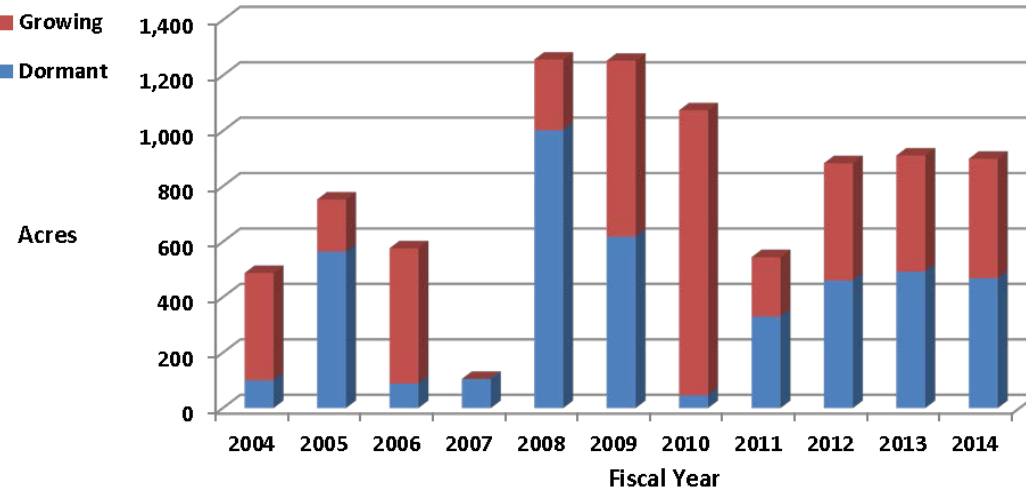

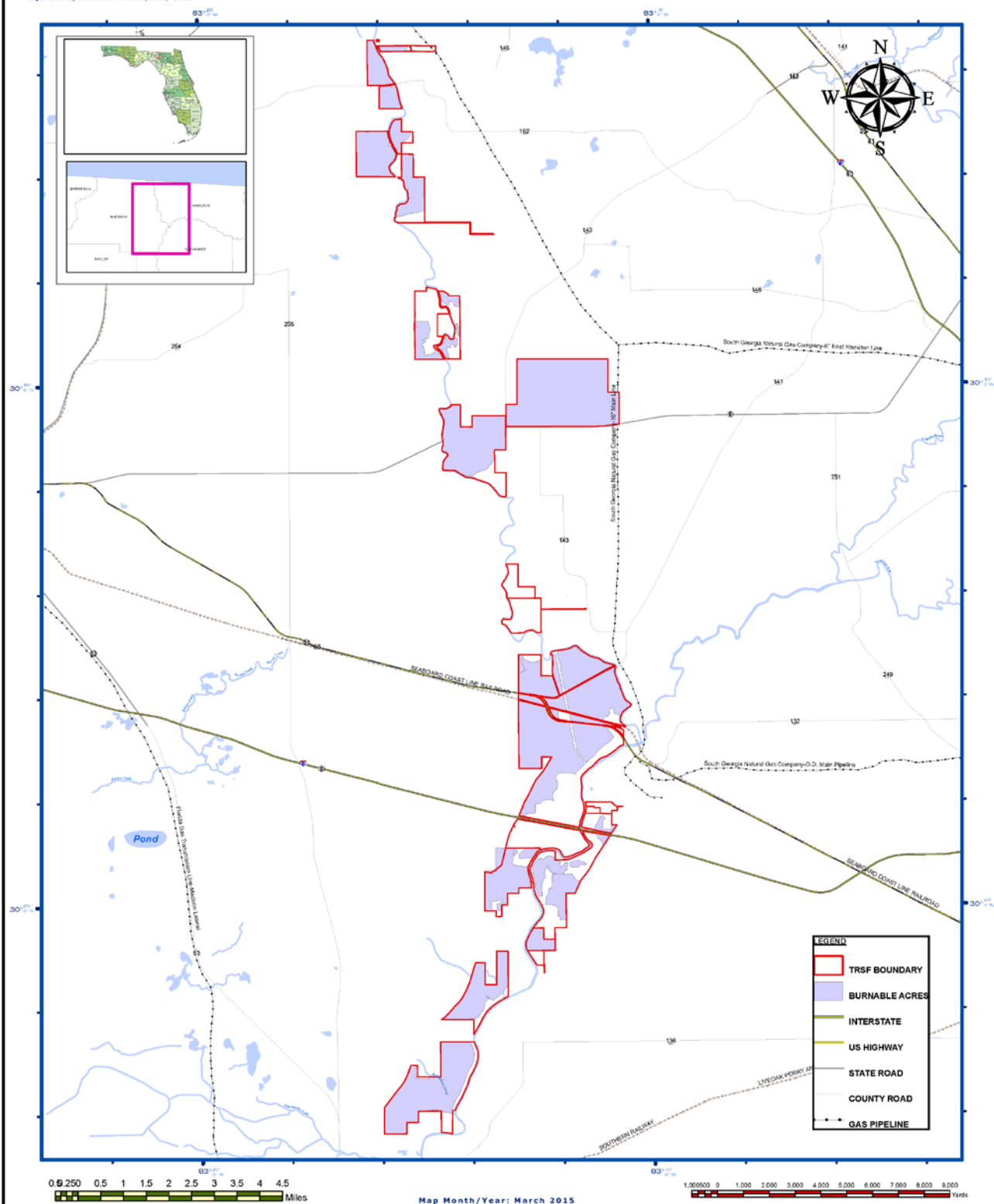

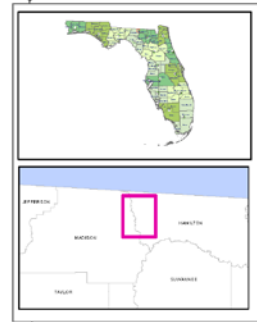
